She is currently the Director of the Digital Belt and Road International Center of Excellence (DBAR-ICoE Bangkok), covering the region of Thailand and Southeast Asia, as well as Deputy Director General of the International Research Center of Big Data for Sustainable Development Goals (CBAS), China. She serves as Asia-Pacific Network on Global Change Research (APN) National Focal Point for Thailand and Chair of the APN Southeast Asia Subregional Committee, and Counselor of the Institute for Global Environmental Strategies (IGES).

She had served on the Boards of the following organizations: Stockholm Environment Institute (SEI), Sweden; United Nations Centre for Regional Development (UNCRD), Japan; United Nations University (UNU) Institute of Water, Environment and Health, Canada; and several other international organizations, including as Regional Councillor for South and East Asia of the International Union for Conservation of Nature - IUCN.
